

LaBabuch Creative Residencies are for people who need space and time to immerse themselves in an artistic project.

LaBabuch is an old farmhouse that has been restored with the help and collaboration of many people. A place surrounded by nature, inviting calmness and concentration, perfect for learning and sharing ideas in the creative fields.

LaBabuch is a project created by Clara Gassull and Israel Ariño. LaBabuch is their home, and their workshop, too.

ABOUT US

Clara Gassull, visual artist and art educator. **Israel Ariño**, photographer and editor at Ediciones Anómalas

Israel and Clara have been working together on artistic and educational projects since 2017. They were both drawn to art through their fascination with the world beyond appearances. They are interested in the things that go unnoticed, that we don't quite understand about the world around us, everyday situations. Their projects are often a dialogue with other fields, such as anthropology, geography, archaeology and geology. Israel works in photography. So does Clara, but she combines it with other artistic languages such as drawing, sculpture and video.

In 2019 they founded LaBabuch, an initiative through which they create and share workshops on language, storytelling and photographic processes. Since 2021 Chiara Capodici is part of the team organinzing and carring out some of the workshops.

In 2023, Clara and Israel launched their creatives residencies to share their workspace with others.

The house is divided into two spaces: La Maison and l'Atelier

LA MAISON

- · Private and/or shared bedrooms
- \cdot Shared kitchen
- \cdot Shared bathroom
- · Shared studio equipped with desks, printers and a photobook library

L'ATELIER

- · Private bedroom
- · Private bathroom and kitchen
- \cdot Studio with worktables
- · Etching press
- \cdot Analogue and digital photo lab

TYPES OF RESIDENCIES

Residency in la maison

With this option, you share the house and facilities with other residents. Single room with a shared bathroom, kitchen and studio, access to the l'Atelier facilities (photo lab and etching press). Breakfast and home-cooked dinner included.

Base price: **€560 per week.**

The minimum stay is one week.

Additional costs*: Technical and/or artistic support and consumables (printing, laboratory chemicals, binding materials, etc.). Please contact us for the price of these services.

Residency in l'atelier

With this option, you get a workspace that is separate from the main house. Private bedroom, bathroom and kitchen, private studio with workbenches, photo lab and etching press.

Base price: €750 per week.

The minimum stay is one week.

Additional costs*: Technical and/or artistic support and consumables (printing, laboratory chemicals, binding materials, etc.). Please contact us for the price of these services.

Residencies for groups

For private groups or collectives in the visual arts, performing arts, literature, cinema, music, etc., contact us about potential collaborations.

TECNICAL AND ARTISTIC SUPPORT



Israel Ariño and Clara Gassull work as teachers and researchers in the field of art, particularly photography. At LaBabuch they offer technical and artistic support for those who need it.

Types of support available*:

- · Portfolio review.
- Support with theory and guidance for artistic projects.
- Storytelling and editing for photography projects.
- Technical assistance in using the darkroom and the etching press.
- Technical support with bookbinding and creating book-objects.
- Technical support with other processes such as platinum/palladium, cyanotype, wet collodion, etc.


The house is located in the Brenne Natural Park,

a perfect environment for walking and enjoying nature. The Camino de Santiago passes in front of the house and at the back there is a path that connects to the nearest villages. The closest river, the Anglin, is a 10-minute walk from the house.

The area is known as a paradise for flora and fauna, and a refuge for many species of migratory birds.




LOCATION AND TRANSPORT

LaBabuch is located in Mérigny,

in the Indre (36) department of central **France**. The nearest cities are Poitiers and Chatêllerault.

The nearest train station is in Montmorillon, where you can be picked up by car. Bus service connects several towns between Poitiers and Le Blanc, which is 15 minutes by car. We can help you find the easiest way to get to our house.

Bicycles for exploring the area are available to residents.



OUR FOOD

At LaBabuch we buy our produce from local markets and the Gaya organic cooperative.

The residencies include breakfast and dinner (family style). Residents are welcome to use the kitchen, which is stocked with the basics (coffee, tea, rice, vegetables, pasta and local fruit). Meals are prepared taking into account participants' specific dietary needs (allergies, intolerances).
